- Lord, give us the willingness to be part of your answer to the prayers we pray

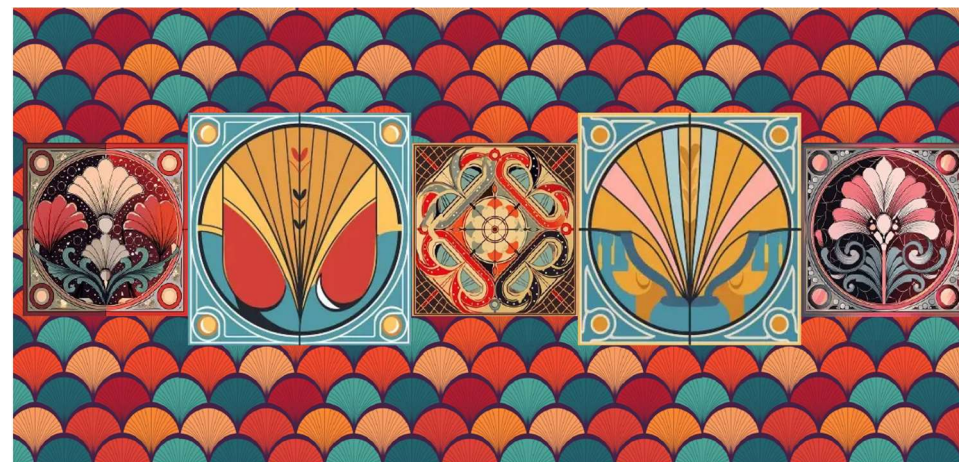

Pastor's Pen

One of our Five Statements in our church Vision is:

Committed to Prayer - Prayer is the engine of the church.

Our corporate prayer spaces continue to be one of my favorite times during the week. Sunday mornings at 9:15am, Tuesday evenings at 7pm and Thursday mornings at 9am. For me personally, this is a time that I often hear God speaking either through other people's prayers, encouragements or testimonies but also through God's still small voice. One of the main themes that has been coming through our prayer meetings again lately has been an encouragement to still ourselves and wait on God. I realise that many of us find this very hard to do. Timothy Keller notes that "Many things are written that we are the least contemplative people in history". I'm sure most of us would agree with this. We are bombarded by information and entertainment, and we can find it extremely difficult just to slow ourselves right down, rid ourselves of distractions and to be still. To wait on God and to listen and reflect.

In Psalm 27 David faces 4 significant life challenges. In verse 2 the wicked are seeking his life; in verse 3 an army is gathering against him to make war; in verse 10 David has been rejected by both his mother and father; and in verse 12 false witnesses are stirring up violence against him.

When you have wicked people seeking your life and armies gathering against you and you are rejected by family and people are invoking violence against you through lies it is understandable to just want to jump into problem solving mode. But for David, even in the midst of such difficulties, his greatest delight was to dwell with God all his days, to gaze upon His beauty and to seek God's direction and guidance for his life (verse 4). With this kind of God focus, even amid his difficulties, David finds a place of shouting for joy and singing songs of praise (verse 6). David's final encouragement to us in Psalm 27 is in verse 14, wait for the LORD.
