Pastor's Pen

As I contemplate this Pastor's Pen the thing that comes to the top of my mind is prayer, and already I am thinking that my next Pastor's Pen, and maybe even the one after that, will be on prayer.

Our Vision Statement describes prayer as being 'the engine' of the Church. Given that, I've been wondering, "How big is our engine at Napier Baptist?" Is our engine big enough to drive all that God has for us as a church? At the moment, I do not think it is.

I have used this quote before in regard to prayer and it remains one of my favourites:

"Prayer is the easiest and hardest of all things; the simplest and the sublimest; the weakest and the most powerful; its results lie outside the range of human possibilities - they are limited only by the omnipotence of God." — E.M. Bounds

On one hand, prayer is the easiest of all things. Through Christ we have full access to God anytime, anywhere. God invites us to come with confidence (boldness) to Him to find help in our time of need, Hebrews 4:6. But in a world so full of entertainment, business, scepticism, and distraction, prayer is also the hardest of all things. It is so easy to find something more pressing to do than to set aside time to pray. This is one reason why I am such an advocate of corporate prayer. These set meetings help discipline us to schedule regular spaces during our week to pray.

Bounds' quote also challenges us to think about the omnipotence (unlimited power) of God when we pray. Often the reason that we don't pray is because we don't feel like our prayers matter. While our prayers may often seem weak and feeble the thing we need to grasp is that prayer is cantered around who God is and not around who we are. Paul puts it this way, "Now to him who is able to do far more abundantly than all that we ask or think, according to the power at work within us." Ephesians 3:20.
